Deepak Ram was born in Johannesburg, South Africa. In 1975, he began studying bansuri (Bamboo Flute) and tabla. In 1981 Deepak became a disciple of Pandit Hariprasad Chaurasia, India's grand master of bansuri.

Deepak has held the post of Lecturer in the Department of Music, University of Durban (South Africa), where he received his master's degree in contemporary composition. His area of study was Exploring the effective synthesis between Indian and Western music.

Deepak has written many works for ballets, plays, choral groups, Western classical musicians, Jazz soloists, and television. His compositions have been released on his own album "Flute for Thought", released in England, as well as on "Indian Dream" by "Emam & Friends" as well as compact discs of North Indian Classical music.

Tabla Accompaniment – Vikas Yendluri has been learning tabla for the past 14 years from Shri Arshad Syed. He also has been receiving guidance from Ustad Zakir Hussain. He is currently a junior at Stanford University.
